WHAT IS THE PROBLEM?

Spent fluorescent tubes and lamps contain **mercury**; it is therefore no longer legal to consign them to ordinary landfill sites. Mercury is a highly toxic substance that is harmful to people and the environment – even in the smallest amounts.



WHAT IS THE LAW?

Fluorescent tubes, and lamps containing mercury, that have reached the end of their life are now classed as **hazardous waste**. Under **The Environmental Protection (Duty of Care) Regulations 1991** you have a **legal obligation** to dispose of such items in accordance with statutory requirements. Any breach of these duty of care regulations **is a criminal offence**.

WHAT IS THE SOLUTION?

The **one stop waste Lamp Recycling Package** is designed to enable you to comply with your legal obligations fully, even when dealing with relatively small lamp volumes. The service utilises the **StoreSafe Tube Containers**; each capable of storing an average of 200 mixed fluorescent tubes and lamps. After you have filled the container, we will arrange to collect it as a single consignment. To achieve full legal compliance, we will then arrange to process 100% of the container contents to recover material for recycling and re-use. The recycling process is in strict accordance with the **Waste Electrical & Electronic Equipment (WEEE) directive**. This directive is expected to be enacted into UK Law by early 2007.

HOW DOES THE LAMP RECYCLING PACKAGE WORK?

1. When we receive the enclosed Fax Back Order Form we will arrange the supply of the StoreSafe tube container most appropriate to your needs. StoreSafe containers are available in 2 standard sizes: the **TC-6** for fluorescent tubes up to 6ft (1800mm) and the **TC-8** for tubes up to 8ft (2400mm). Each container will store on average 200 fluorescent tubes of varying lengths and diameters.
2. Simply call us on **01224 782050** when the StoreSafe container is full.
3. We will then arrange to collect and transport the filled container to our **Accredited Recycling Facility**, where your fluorescent tubes will be recycled in accordance with the WEEE directive.
4. At the time of collection you will receive the required documentation for the handling and transportation of your lamp consignment. This will also incorporate a Recycling Certificate for your records.



The robust TC-6 and TC-8 StoreSafe containers are fully lined and fitted with a removable lid. They are suitable for both indoor and outdoor use.

HOW MUCH WILL THIS LAMP RECYCLING PACKAGE COST?

Our competitive all-inclusive quotation will cover:

- Delivery of one (1) StoreSafe tube container of your choice to any UK mainland destination.
- Use of the container until such time it has been filled to capacity.
- Collection and transportation of the full container back to our Lamp Recycling Centre.

- Issue of a Certificate of Recycling for each lamp consignment.
- Issue of the statutory documentation required by SEPA for the movement of the waste.
